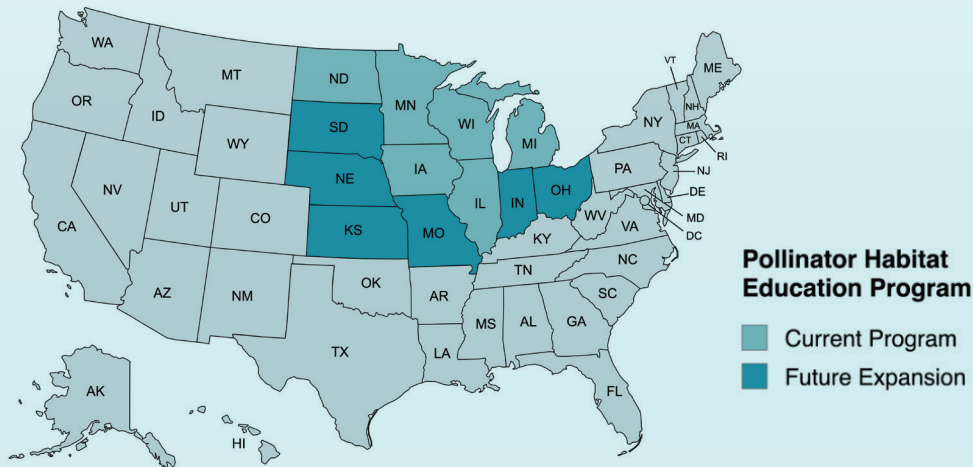




Pollinator Habitat Education Program
